Leo, as he prefers to be called, is a lecturer and researchers at the Indonesian Consortium for Religious Studies and Duta Wacana Christian University. He teaches classes on Christianity, Judaism, History of Religions, and the Church and Popular Culture. He is an elder in the Indonesian Christian Church. His church is called GKI Gejayan. GKI stands for Gereja Kristen Indonesia and “Gejayan” is where the church is located. The church is part of the Dutch Reformed Tradition and has about 1,000 members. The attendance for seven weekly services is around 6,000-7,000! He supervises and coordinates the catechism program, Bible studies, as well as, works with youth, adult and senior ministries. He is involved in many interfaith programs, organizations and activities as well.

Leo married his wife Mimi, in 1996, and they have two daughters – Kezia (17) and Katya (10). Mimi is also a church activist. Kezia is a high school student and an amateur writer. Katya is in elementary school and a pianist.
