Some papers are for action and will require a vote. For some action papers, reading them will suffice and you may decide you do not need to print them and bring them to the meeting. There are other papers that you may wish to print and carry with you. Keep in mind that what is easy to you is sometimes open to a lot of debate: If amendments are made or there is a lot of debate, you may find yourself at a loss if there is significant debate or discussion over a paper you do not have with you.
